

MOORABOOL Wind Farm

JUNE 2017 UPDATE

For construction, Moorabool Wind Farm is split into 2 sections:

- Moorabool North and
- Moorabool South.

Please see the attached maps.

Moorabool North

Moorabool North consists of the 50 turbines from Mt Egerton Road running south to Hamills Lane. Development Plans for Moorabool North have now been submitted to the Minister for Planning for his approval. These plans outline exactly what will be built at Moorabool North.

We are currently recruiting for 3 positions required throughout construction:

Offsite construction for Moorabool North is expected to begin in July 2017 i.e. upgrades to public roads and upgrades to site access points.

Onsite construction for Moorabool North is expected to begin in approximately September/October 2017. Please see the attached timeline.

Moorabool South

Moorabool South consists of 57 turbines running south from Hamills Lane towards Elaine. For Moorabool South, Goldwind is continuing to work through the requirements of the planning permit conditions to ensure a suitable turbine layout design. Development plans for submission to the Minister are now being prepared. We anticipate submitting the development plans to the Minister in six to eight weeks. At that time, we will be able to provide you with an update as to the design of the layout.
