

MOORABOOL Wind Farm



Welcome to the second edition of the Moorabool Wind Farm newsletter. This newsletter provides information and updates about the project. Further newsletters will be produced at regular intervals as the project progresses and milestones are achieved.

Moorabool Wind project is located approximately 4km south of Ballan, 67km west of Melbourne, 27km east of Ballarat and 47km northwest of Geelong.

What's Happening?

For construction, Moorabool Wind Farm is split into 2 sections: North and South.



North

Moorabool North consists of 50 turbines from Mt Egerton Road running south to Hamills Lane. Development Plans for Moorabool North have now been submitted to the Minister for Planning for his approval. These plans outline exactly what will be built at Moorabool North and proposed environmental management systems.

Offsite construction for Moorabool North is expected to begin soon, including upgrades to public roads and site access points. Onsite construction for Moorabool North is expected to begin in the third quarter 2017.

South

Moorabool South consists of 57 turbines running south from Hamills Lane towards Morrisons. The project team is continuing to work through the requirements of the planning permit conditions to ensure a suitable turbine layout design. Development plans for submission to the Minister are now being prepared. We anticipate submitting the development plans to the Minister in four to six weeks. An update on the wind farm layout will be available at that time.

Community Reference Group (CRG)

The first meeting of the CRG was held in May at the Ballan Mechanics Institute. There are 10 community members of the group including: Christopher Carroll – Chair, Mark Conlan, Rob Croxford – Moorabool Shire Council, Joy Geoghegan, Ann Hardwick, David Hookey and Karen Marsh. Representatives of the project also attend meetings to provide updates as the project progresses. The aim of the CRG is to provide a forum for open discussion between representatives of Moorabool Wind Farm, the community, local councils and other stakeholders, and to keep the community informed of progress.

Community Benefits

Moorabool Wind Farm aims to successfully integrate the project into the community and to disseminate the benefits throughout the community.

Neighbour Involvement (Electricity) Scheme.

Houses within 3km of a wind turbine are eligible to participate in this scheme. It offers homeowners \$1,500 per year to contribute towards their electricity usage costs. For more information or to sign up, please contact Helen Kennedy on 0472 832 552.

Community Fund

The annual community fund will be available once the wind farm is operational. This will be approximately \$100 -200,000 for community groups to apply for each year. Further details on the criteria and process will be available in due course.
