The Project

Moorabool Wind farm was approved by the Minister for Planning in 2010 after a process of consideration of impact assessments and evidence presented at a panel hearing.

Moorabool Wind Farm is now working through a process to determine the most appropriate Goldwind Turbines that comply with the strict conditions set by the Planning Permit.Construction is expected to begin later this year.

Business Boost

Moorabool Wind Farm in partnership with the Industry Capability Network (ICN) is keen to maximise the use of local business throughout the construction of the wind farm.

WHY MOORABOOL?



Moorabool Wind Farm is contributing to the Victorian Renewable Energy Target of **25%** by **2020** and **40%** by **2025**



Wind energy can reduce greenhouse gas emissions by substituting for fossil fuel generated electricity, and provide a sustainable supply of energy.



The natural terrain and consistent wind speeds in this area are significant and the connection to the electricity network is also strong. The project is expected to produce **900,000 MWh of electricity annually.**



This is enough renewable energy to power the equivalent of **183,000 average Victorian homes annually.**



That represents **9% of Victorian homes.**



Community Benefits

Moorabool Wind Farm aims to successfully integrate the project into the community and to disseminate the benefits throughout the community. We aim to build respectful relationships allowing stakeholder and community support for, and identification with, project operations and goals. We also aim to encompass best practice community engagement and endeavour to go beyond minimum standards for planning and compliance to facilitate an engaged community who consider the project part of their community.
