Moorabool North Wind Farm

Progress to date

- Installation of all fifty (50) turbines complete.
- Energisation of substation complete.
- Commissioning of fifty (50) turbines complete.
- Australian Energy Market Operator (AEMO) Registration complete.
- AEMO Compliance (Hold Point testing) commenced (75MW).

Look ahead

- AEMO Compliance (Hold Point testing) to continue – increased operations.

Moorabool South Wind Farm

Progress to date

- Installation of all Fifty-Four (54) turbines complete.
- All access tracks, hardstands and substation complete.
- Energisation of substation complete.
- Pre-Commissioning of Fifty-Two (52) turbines complete

Look ahead

- Road maintenance and repairs will continue as we monitor regularly.
- Ongoing commissioning of turbines.

Landscape and Visual Screening Program

Owners of residential dwellings within 4km of the Moorabool Wind Farm are invited to participate in a landscape and visual screening program.

This is to assist those closest neighbours in reducing the potential visual impacts of the project. All agreed works are undertaken by Moorabool Wind Farm at no cost to dwelling owners.

Expressions of interest will be accepted until 12 months after commissioning of the last turbine at either Moorabool North or Moorabool South Wind Farm.

Public Road Resurfacing at Moorabool South Wind Farm

Sections of Mount Wallace Ballark Road and Bungeeltap South Road are expected to be resurfaced between mid-September and late November 2021. This may involve road closures and speed reductions along sections of the roads for a period of time.
