

Media Statement 21 April 2026

We would like to provide an update on the removal and remediation of asbestos identified within brake pad components of internal service equipment in some wind turbines at Moorabool Wind Farm.

We are pleased to confirm that all asbestos has now been removed from both the North and South wind farm sites. Replacement works are ongoing at turbines, with affected equipment continuing to be remediated. We anticipate that these works will be completed by the end of May. With the removal of all asbestos-affected components, approval has been given to the service teams to safely resume turbine maintenance works.

Protecting the health and safety of our teams, contractors and the community remains our highest priority. We will continue to work with Goldwind to ensure that they have the access and support they need to undertake these works safely. A further update on the progress of the replacement activities will be provided in due course.
